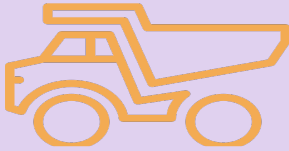


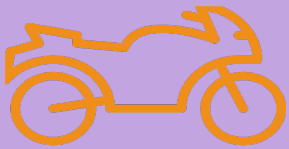
WHAT KINDS OF TRANSPORTATION CAN WE SEE?

What To Do:



When you are out on a walk or a drive with your child, bring along a pencil and a paper for a transportation scavenger hunt.



The object of the scavenger hunt is to find as many different types of transportation as you can. Write down all the different forms of transportation that you and your child see. You may want to create categories on your sheet, such as transportation on roads, on rails, on water, in the air.



Discuss with your child why each type of transportation is in a given category. Which had the greatest number of types of transportation? Was this a surprise?



Try this activity on a different day and compare the results to the first time. What differences did you notice? Were you surprised?
